Members & Guests Dress Code Updated: 2024

- Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests are aware of and always observe this dress code.
- Golf wear should be smart, clean, and appropriate for play on the course. Tailored shorts are acceptable. T-shirts must have a collar unless designed for golf. Jeans are not permitted attire for play on the course.
- Outdoor golf clothing, such as rainwear, footwear including trainer type golf shoes, hats, and other golf equipment are acceptable in the locker rooms only.
- Within the Club House, clothing must always be at a minimum of smart casual level.
- Smart denim jeans will be acceptable in the clubhouse provided they are not torn, cut or bleached. Clean non golf trainers will also be acceptable in the clubhouse.
- The following items of clothing are not acceptable at any time on the course or in the Clubhouse; football and rugby shirts, jogging bottoms unless specifically designed for golf, singlets, untailored shorts, tracksuits, flipflops or sliders.
- Any garments including shirts or T-shirts carrying slogans, numbers or illustrations that are not golf related are not acceptable.
- Outdoor coats, jackets and hats must remain in the locker rooms or placed on the rack in the entrance hall and not over the backs of chairs in the lounges or dining room.
- As a gentle reminder, the club expects members and visitors to avail of the appropriate locker rooms to prepare for their round of golf.
 Please refrain from changing shoes and clothing in the car park.
